The choral setting is by Lloyd Larson. These two composers combined Oliver's contemporary melody with Ludwig van Beethoven's Ode to Joy.

Both Gary Oliver and Lloyd Larson are working church musicians. Bishop Gary Oliver has been writing very contemporary praise style songs for years. This piece was first published in 1988 and this arrangement was written in 2006. Lloyd Larson is a contemporary composer of choral works. He actually lives in the Minneapolis/St. Paul area. I have attended a number of Larson's choral clinics. He writes for all variety of choirs. I heard him present this choral piece at a workshop. He emphasizes scripture and how much church choirs can be ministers of the word through music.

This Easter we sing about the resurrection, alleluias, and hymns of gladness. "He who on the cross a victim for the world's salvation bled. Jesus Christ, the King of Glory, now is risen from the
