Greetings from the Choir,

As we begin, Holy Week, we start by celebrating Jesus' entrance into Jerusalem. In our scripture, Luke 19:28-40, we read the story of Jesus entering Jerusalem and people shouting, "Blessed is the king who comes in the name of the Lord!" We will enter our sanctuary with the waving of palms, and the singing and playing of instruments to the hymn *All Glory Laud and Honor*. Towards the end of this Palm Sunday worship, the choir will introduce the story of the passion of our Lord.

The anthem, **See Gethsemane**, is composed by J. Paul Williams and Lloyd Larson. The melody and choral rendition, brings to us the emotion of the upcoming days, as we once again hear and experience the story of God's love for us. Vision Board Update: Remodeling plans

New flooring will be installed starting on April 21. Again, the fellowship hall and office entry way will be replaced with LVP flooring (luxury vinyl plank)
Work should take about a week to complete, with accommodations made to not interrupt Ruby's Pantry. Please avoid coming in the building whenever possible throughout the week.
Carpet in Fireside room and hallway will be cleaned after flooring is installed.
We asked for a bid from Property One (who is installing the flooring) to paint the Fireside Room.
We will also have a plumber install a FloLogic device. This device senses water flowing after hours and will provide notification and shut the water off.
Our difference in cost from what we received from insurance claim, will be approximately \$5000.00. This cost may increase pending what the base floor in Fellowship Hall is like after

carpet is removed.

- Our teams were asked last month to look at their 2025 Budget to reduce what they can but not disrupt needed plans. We were able to reduce our budget by \$3,000.00.

Pastor Luci and our property team, Jerry Wisnewski and Tuenis Zondag, have been working very hard to keep the above plan organized and on target. We extend our thanks!!



Thursday, May 8


