



The Old Rugged Cross

We are approaching Palm Sunday... listening to the retelling of Jesus entering Jerusalem, surrounded by praises to the Lord. Yet we also realize in this Sunday's scripture that this is the beginning of Holy Week and Jesus's Road to the Cross.

The choir anthem, this Sunday of Passion, is <u>The Old Rugged Cross</u>. This song was written by George Bennard in 1913 and is still sung today. I normally choose songs that are written in today's styles and harmonies. But I saw this song in our files and remembered generations before me sang this song. It has some great harmonies in that old barbershop style and the lyrics are still relevant today. The composer wrote the melody but could only give it the title *The Old Rugged Cross*. The lyrics would not come to him until he concentrated on the bible verse John 3:16. *16 For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life*. Once he relied on scripture, the verses came to him, and this old song has survived for over a hundred years.

"In the old rugged cross, stained with blood so divine, a wondrous beauty I see; For t'was on that old cross, Jesus suffered and died to pardon and sanctify me....I will cling to the old rugged cross...and exchange it some day for a crown."
