Dear Journey Family,

We want to share some very difficult news with you. A few weeks ago a small mass was removed from Barry's side. The pathology revealed that it was cancerous. He had a CT scan last week to investigate this. We were concerned, but he had just had PET scans and x-rays a few months ago, before prostate surgery, and all was clear.

The results of his CT were shocking. Barry has multiorgan metastatic cancer of spine, muscle, lungs, liver, kidney, adrenal glands, and ribs. Chemotherapy is available, but will not cure, and would require biopsies that could have serious, life-threatening, side effects.

Barry has decided to seek only palliative care. I fully agree with him.

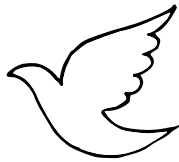
